# WHITE WINES

## PINOT GRIGIO

**Anterra** - 28

**Alois Lageder** - 24 - **SPLIT BOTTLE**

Brilliant straw yellow color with green shimmer and with flowery and spicy notes - this winery is one of the first ones in Italy to convert to biodynamic viticulture

**Barone Fini** - 30

Classic Italian pinot grigio, fresh with medium body and acidity, green apple notes; good for sipping and to accompany a variety of seafood and lighter dishes

## CHARDONNAY

**Whitewater Hill Barrel Select** - 38 - **local winery** - Lightly oaked local chardonnay

**Frescobaldi Pomino** - 49

This is actually a blend of chardonnay and pinot bianco—elegant, well balanced and fresh

**Vie di Romans 2015** - 66

A beautiful, intense and elegant chardonnay from the Northern Italian region of Friuli—matured for 9 months on lees—no oak

**Anterra** - 28 - Stainless steel fermented.

## PINOT BIANCO

**Tramin** - 52

This wine comes from high in the Alpine region of Trentino Alto Adige—it is rich, dry, with great acidity—beautiful as an aperitif or with seafood dishes

## VERMENTINO

**Argiolas Costamolino** - 32

Argiolas is one of the most famous wineries in the island of Sardegna and their philosophy is to use only indigenous grapes. This wine is 95% vermentino and 5% other Sardinian grapes with partial malolactic fermentation to add richness - delicate citrus flavors with notes of tropical fruits and honey; great acidity makes it a very food-friendly wine

## ROSE WINES

**Colterris Coral**

**LOCAL WINERY** Estate produced in Palisade from Cabernet Sauvignon grapes—slightly off-dry with great acidity and strawberry and raspberry notes - 44

**MÜLLER THURGAU** - This is a white wine grape variety used predominately in Germany, Switzerland, and the Alpine region of Italy. It was created in 1882 by crossing Riesling and Madeleine Royal grapes by Doctor Müller Thurgau.

**Castel Firmian—47**

Fresh and fruity wine with hints of white peach and notes of sage and thyme—refreshing wine as an aperitif or paired with fish, fresh cheeses, and salads

**ROERO ARNEIS**

**Monchiero Carbone - 56**

This is one of the best whites from Piemonte- elegant, dry, medium body with a subtle effervescence on the palate; citrus and melon aroma with hints of almonds

**SOAVE**

**Suavia Soave Classico - 36**

A “must try” wine—100% garganega grapes—dry, medium to full body, high acidity, notes of pears, apples and almonds - elegant and harmonious soave

**MOSCATO**

**Cascinetta Vietti Moscato d’Asti - 26 - SPLIT BOTTLE**

**Whitewater Hill—local winery** - still Moscato Canelli, delicious just like the Italians minus the bubbles - 34

**SAUVIGNON BLANC**

**Tenuta Luisa Sauvignon Blanc - 40**

Beautiful tropical fruits notes, bright and supple

**Russiz Superiore Collio 2020- 65**

From one of the most famous winemakers in Northern Italy, Marco Felluga, this is a complex, full body sauvignon blanc - 15% of the must was fermented in oak to add complexity - green pepper and pink grapefruit on the nose, lemon and grapefruit on the palate

## PINOT NOIR

**Stemmari** - 28 - From Sicily

## MERLOT

**Two Rivers Winery** - 33 - local winery

**Whitewater Hill** - 41 - local winery

## SYRAH

**Whitewater Hill Shiraz** - 44 - local winery - Rich notes of black pepper and plum. Full palate with soft plum, black raspberries.

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

**Two Rivers Winery** - 40 - local winery

**Feudo Arancio** - 30 - From Sicily

## CABERNET FRANC

**Russiz Superiore Collio 2018** - 69

From one of the most famous winemakers in Italy, Marco Felluga - the most unique and intense cabernet franc I have ever tasted - spicy, full body, complex, elegant

## SWEET RED WINE

**Carlson Sweet Baby Red** - 25 - local winery

## ST. VINCENT

**Whitewater Hill St. Vincent** - 43 - local winery Indigenous grape to the United States. Almost like an American version of Sangiovese. Red currant and raspberry nose. Cranberry and apple flavors on the palate with a dried herb finish.

## CHIANTI

**Castello di Bossi Chianti Classico** - 41

**Nozzole Chianti Classico Riserva 2018**- 48

Aged two years in barrel and one year in bottle

**Nozzole Chianti Classico Riserva 2017** - 29 - **SPLIT BOTTLE**

## SANGIOVESE GROSSO

**Nannetti Brunello di Montalcino 2016** - 135

This estate lies in a splendid valley 480 m above sea level where after carefully selecting the grapes from the vines and a vinification at controlled temperatures the wine is left to age in the family's 15th century cellars.

**Fossacolle Rosso di Montalcino 2019** - 75

Basically a "baby" Brunello without the steep price tag

**Argiano Brunello di Montalcino 2017** - 144

Very approachable Brunello, powerful and intense but without the sharpness of most other young Brunello wines

## VINO NOBILE DI MONTEPULCIANO

**Fattoria del Cerro 2018** - 49

Also made from sangiovese grapes, vino nobile comes exclusively from the area around the hill town of Montepulciano and is not to be confused with the montepulciano grape that produces the wine with the same name

## MORELLINO

**Poliziano Lohsa** - 34

Another form of sangiovese grown along the Tuscan coast—produced by one of the best wineries in the Montepulciano area

## SANGIOVESE

**Di Majo Norante** - 29 - organically grown

## MONICA

### **Argiolas Perdera —36**

Indigenous grape from the island of Sardegna, rarely seen anywhere else - medium body, with gentle tannins, red berry, herbs and earthy tones - great overall food wine

## MALBEC

### **Colterris 2018 —47—local winery**

One of the newest wineries in the valley but always producing some of the best wines around here

## PETIT VERDOT

### **Colterris 2018—52—local winery**

Another beautiful wine from this estate winery—dry with full body

## CORVINA BASED WINES

### **Zenato Valpolicella - 34**

Perfect combination of fruity and earthy - this wine is so eclectic that it pairs well with a large number of dishes on our menu

### **Allegrini Palazzo della Torre—42—Great Value, Great Wine**

This is a unique wine that contains 30% of Amarone in the blend

### **Righetti Campolieti Ripasso 2019 - 44**

### **Zenato Amarone Classico Della Valpolicella 2014/15 - 76- SPLIT BOTTLE**

Another great wine and a split bottle is a great way to enjoy a great wine without breaking the bank

### **Righetti Capitel De' Roari Amrone Della Valpolicella Classico 2017 - 94**

### **Righetti Amarone della Valpolicella Classico 2008 - 281**

A special release for this wine - only 1130 bottles made and only 18 came to Colorado

## TEROLDEGO ROTALIANO

### **Castel Firmian Nerofino - 2014 - 32**

A 50/50 blend of Teroldego Rotaliano and Lagrein. A fruity, juicy wine witch pairs well with food at a very friendly price

## NEBBIOLO BASED WINES

### **Vietti Nebbiolo Perbacco 2019** - 65

Just two months short of being a Barolo!

### **Vietti Barolo Castiglione 2018** - 136

One of Robert Parker's favorite wines and a great entry to Barolo wines

### **Travaglini Gattinara 2017** - 85

From the small producing area of Gattinara in Northern Piedmont, this wine is made like a barbaresco but without the price tag - don't forget to look at the bottle and its unique shape, which was patented by the Travaglini family in 1958

### **Silvio Grasso Barolo Bricco Manzoni 2010** - 208

One of the lesser known producers of Barolo whose vineyards are located in La Morra, one of the best areas of production of Barolo wine. This particular wine present the traditional characteristics of a Barolo in a classy and elegant way

### **Podere Elia Barbaresco 2012** - 137

Full-bodied.

### **La Ganghija Barbaresco 2016** - 124

Great wine from an amazing vintage

**Barolo is considered the king of Piedmont wines while Barbaresco is considered the queen, intense but more approachable and softer than the powerful barolo**

## BARBERA

### **Araldica Barbera d'Asti Superiore 2015** - 48 - Fruity and lively

### **Vietti Barbera d'Alba Scarrone 2017** - 107

Amazing Barbera treated with the care of a Barolo

## NERO D'AVOLA

### **Feudo Maccari** - 46

The most important red grape of Sicily—medium body with smooth tannins

**Stemmari Hedonis** - 120 - **Great Value, Amazing Wine** - This Riserva is a true interpretation of the sicilian pursuit of pleasure. 50% of the grapes go through oak aging while the other 50% are left to hang longer on the vine before both are combined to make this special wine.



## GAGLIOPPO BLEND

### **Librandi Gravello Val di Neto Rosso 2017**—66

The most important wine for the Librandi winery: a beautiful blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Gaglioppo grapes, full body, earthy and smooth

## PRIMITIVO

**Mottura Primitivo Del Salento 2019** - 31 - Intense ripe red fruit aroma with a dry velvety taste.

### **Mottura Stilio Primitivo di Manduria 2017** - 120

Unique and interesting Primitivo made in the style of Amarone - the Primitivo grapes are dried before being pressed, giving the wine more bold and robust flavor

## INTERNATIONAL STYLE BLENDS

### **Aia Vecchia Sor Ugo Bolgheri Superiore 2018** - 82

Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot and Petit Verdot—a classic Supertuscan

### **Marchesi Antinori Il Bruciato 2020**- 57

Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Syrah—one of the most affordable Supertuscan wines from one of the most prestigious wineries in Bolgheri.

### **Terre di San Leonardo**—41

A beautiful blend of 40% merlot, 50% cabernet sauvignon and 10% carmenere from the Dolomites

## AGLIANICO

### **Terredora di Paolo Fatica Contadina Taurasi 2013**—85

This is the famous aglianico wine that is produced from vines that grow on the slopes of Mount Vesuvius—aged for 18 months in oak barrels then in bottle for 24 months—full body, complex, with dark fruit and tobacco notes—beautiful wine

## **CANNONAU**

**Argiolas Costera** - 43

From the island of Sardegna, cannonau is the same grape as garnacha in Spain and Granache in France - deliciously rustic and earthy

## **DOLCETTO**

**Fontanabianca Dolcetto d'Alba** - 43

Medium body red wine from Piemonte, a great food wine

## **FREISA**

**Borgogno Langhe Freisa 2014** - 53

One of the lesser known grapes of Piemonte—medium body, red cherries, pleasant tannins, good acidity

## **MONTEPULCIANO and MONTEPULCIANO BLENDS**

**Valle Reale San Calisto 2010** - 100

Organically grown - From the oldest vines at the winery - rich, full body, with soft tannins - award winner every year

**Di Majo Norante Ramitello Biferno Rosso** - 40

A blend of 80% montepulciano and 20% aglianico from Molise—a great value for the quality of this wine—intense, elegant, with dark fruit, licorice and leather notes—dry but with soft tannins

## **NEGROAMARO**

**Mottura Negroamaro 2018** - 31 - Red fruit, licorice and spices. A Harmonic, fresh, smooth wine with balanced tannins.
